**TRST 5295. Special Topics. (1-6 Credits)**

With a change in topic, may be repeated for a maximum of six credits.

May be repeated for credit

**TRST 5310. Literary Translation: Theory and Practice. (3 Credits)**

A study of the theoretical and practical aspects of literary translation.

Translating literature from various genres. May be repeated for a maximum of nine credits with a change of topic.

**Enrollment Requirements:** Six credits of upper division coursework 3000-level or higher in a foreign language or the equivalent.

May be repeated for a total of 9 credits

**TRST 5311. Literary Translation Seminar. (3 Credits)**

Translating literature and studying the practical aspects of the craft of literary translation. May be repeated for a maximum of nine credits with a change of topic.

**Enrollment Requirements:** Six credits of upper division coursework 3000-level or higher in a foreign language or the equivalent.

May be repeated for a total of 9 credits

**TRST 5320. Portfolio Translation Seminar. (3 Credits)**

Translation of literature of any genre or period into English, working toward a final publishable text. Includes preparation of a conference-length paper related to translation theory or practice.
