AAAS 3295 Special Topics in Asian American Studies and AAAS 4999 Independent Study require prior consent of the Minor Advisor for fulfillment of minor. Students must earn a grade of "C" or better in each of the courses applied to the minor. A maximum of three credits towards the minor may be transfer credits of courses equivalent to University of Connecticut courses.
