

LITERARY TRANSLATION MINOR

In the Literary Translation Minor, students will practice the craft of translating literary texts from any language into English and explore international theories of literary translation.

Requirements

The Literary Translation Minor consists of a minimum 15 credits at the 2000-level or above.

- A. Two required translation courses: TRST 3010 Translating Literature: Practice and Theory and TRST 3011 The Art of Literary Translation.
- B. Two literary/cultural courses chosen from: ARAB, CAMS, CHIN, CLCS, CRLP, FREN, GERM, HIND, ILCS, JAPN, KORE, MGRK, PERS, PLSH, PORT, RUSS, SPAN, TRST, VIET.
- C. One creative writing or related genre course from English chosen from:
